Carpark

Just a reminder that the staff carpark at the rear of the school is only for staff members and anyone who has spoken with the office about using the disabled carpark for pick up and drop off. We have had an increasing number of people coming down the driveway and this is a safety issue with students leaving via the driveaway exit.

We would also like to remind parents about the front carpark and the bay out the front, please be considerate of others when using these carparks. Several parents have been pulling into the staff carpark driveway and sitting waiting for their child/ren, or stopping in the bay causing congestion which flows out onto the road and affects the crossing. Both of these practices are incredibly dangerous with students coming down the stairs to meet parents in the bay carpark and exiting onto the street. The Constable has advised that we can expect more regular visits from the parking wardens who will be issuing tickets to illegally parked cars in the second half of the year to assist with some of the traffic issues we have been experiencing.
